 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Do or Dye Act".

5 SEC. 2. FOOD CONTAINING CERTAIN COLOR ADDITIVES 6 DEEMED ADULTERATED.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the listing and8 certification (or exemption in effect with respect to such

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certification) of any covered color additive pursuant to sec tion 721 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act
 (21 U.S.C. 379e), effective beginning on the date of this
 Act—

5 (1) a covered color additive is deemed unsafe
6 for use in or on food within the meaning of sub7 section (a) of such section; and

8 (2) a food that is, or it bears or contains, such
9 a color additive is adulterated within the meaning of
10 section 402(c) of such Act (21 U.S.C. 342(c)).

(b) COVERED COLOR ADDITIVE.—In this Act, the
term "covered color additive" means the following color
additives (as such term is defined in section 201 of the
Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 321)):

- 15 (1) Red No. 40.
- 16 (2) Yellow No. 5.
- 17 (3) Yellow No. 6.

18 (4) Any additive that is substantially similar to
19 the additives specified in paragraphs (1) through
20 (4).
