3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "No Toxic Chemicals5 in Cosmetics Act".

1SEC. 2. ADULTERATED SUNSCREEN AND COSMETICS CON-2TAINING PARABENS.

3 (a) SUNSCREEN CONTAINING PARABENS.—Section
4 501 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21
5 U.S.C. 351) is amended by inserting after paragraph (j)
6 the following:

7 "(k) If it is a drug that—

8 "(1) contains 1 or more active ingredients in-9 tended for application to the skin of humans for 10 purposes of absorbing, reflecting, or scattering ultra-11 violet radiation; and

12 "(2) bears or contains parabens, including 13 esters of parahydroxybenzoic acid, which include 14 methylparaben. ethylparaben, propylparaben, 15 isopropylparaben. butylparaben. isobutylparaben. 16 benzylparaben, phenylparaben, and pentylparaben.". 17 (b) COSMETICS CONTAINING PARABENS.—Section 601 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 18 19 U.S.C. 361) is amended by adding at the end the fol-20 lowing:

"(h) If it bears or contains parabens, including esters
of parahydroxybenzoic acid, which include methylparaben,
ethylparaben, propylparaben, butylparaben,
isopropylparaben, isobutylparaben, benzylparaben,
phenylparaben, and pentylparaben.".

(c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub sections (a) and (b) shall apply only with respect to drugs
 and cosmetics introduced or delivered for introduction into
 interstate commerce on or after the date that is 2 years
 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
