A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to modify the eligibility requirements for asylum.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Refugees Using Legal

5 Entry Safely Act" or "RULES Act".

6 SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF ASYLUM ELIGIBILITY.

7 Section 208(a) of the Immigration and Nationality

8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1158(a)) is amended—

3	"(1) Application at ports of entry.—
4	"(A) IN GENERAL.—Any alien who arrives
5	at a port of entry of the United States, irre-
6	spective of such alien's status, may, only at
7	such a port of entry, apply for asylum in ac-
8	cordance with this section or, as applicable, sec-
9	tion 235(b).
10	"(B) PROHIBITION ON PAROLE OR RE-
11	LEASE INTO THE UNITED STATES.—Notwith-
12	standing section $236(a)(2)$, an alien applying
13	for asylum at a port of entry may not be pa-
14	roled or released into the United States.";

16	(A) by striking subparagraph (B)
17	(B) in subparagraph (C), by striking "Sub-

20	(C) by striking subparagraph (D);
21	(D) in subparagraph (E), by striking
22	"Subparagraphs (A) and (B)" and inserting

(E) by redesignating subparagraphs (C)
 and (E) as subparagraphs (B) and (C), respec tively; and
 (F) by adding at the end the following:
 "(D) EFFECT OF APPREHENSION IN THE
 UNITED STATES.—Paragraph (1) shall not

apply to any alien who is apprehended by or referred to the Secretary of Homeland Security as
an alien who has entered the United States
without inspection and admission or who has
remained in the United States beyond the
alien's period of authorized stay."; and

(3) by striking "Attorney General" each place
it appears and inserting "Attorney General or the
Secretary of Homeland Security, as applicable,".
